# The Art SHAC Donation List

Materials must be CLEAN (no stains, odors, mildew, animal hair) and in usable condition.

All donations are subject to staff approval based on size and space limitations.

This list is not comprehensive. It is designed to give you an idea of the materials that we accept.

## Artists paints, drawing materials, tools & supplies

- watercolor, acrylic, oil paints, and gesso (not dried out)
- gel mediums
- like new brushes
- canvases, wood canvases
- colored pencils, charcoals, pastels
- printmaking items

\*\*\*no house paints or spray paints\*\*\*

## Art Paper & paper

- Standard Copy Paper (plain, colored, cardstock, etc.)
- Scrapbooking paper, packs and pads, paper embellishments
- Watercolor paper, drawing pads, collage paper
- Butcher Paper (rolls)
- Paper Sample Books, Maps, Calendars (new and used)
- Art & Vintage Magazines (art/craft related or National Geographics)
- Art Books
- Blank journals
- Postage Stamps
- Old Blueprints

\*\*\*We do not accept little bits of paper\*\*\*

## Fabric, fibers, and notions

- fabric yardage minimum  $\frac{1}{4}$  yard at a standard width
- embroidery supplies
- knitting supplies
- macrame supplies
- vintage napkins & hand towels
- Notions: Zippers, Buttons, Beads, Thread, Needles, Pins, Trim, Lace, Ribbon, Velcro, Leather
- sewing patterns

## General craft supplies

- Glue, tape, duct tape
- Scissors & paper cutters
- Dowels, pom poms, pipe cleaners
- Glitter & google eyes
- Modge podge
- Chalk
- Ink Stamp and pads
- Doll making items
- Scrapbooking supplies & albums
- Stencils & transfer letters
- Cigar boxes

## Framing supplies

- Mat Board (6" X 6" and larger, cut and uncut; NO strips),
- Foam Core (12" X 12" and larger)
- **Pausing Frames (with or without glass, NO broken glass),  
Acrylic plexiglass**
- Corrugated Plastic

## Media/Tech parts and pieces for projects

- Vinyl Records
- Film Canisters, old photographs & slides
- Working slide projectors or overheads
- Telephone wire, wire (no power cords)
- Vintage equipment or media
- Jewelry: for making jewelry or completed jewelry
- Beads & Jewelry making materials, tools, containers, and displays,
- Jewelry (earrings, necklaces, bracelets, watches, broaches)
- School & Office supplies
- Pens (usable), pencils, erasers, markers (usable), crayons, chalk
- Scissors, hole punches, staplers, staples (standard size only), rulers
- Staple removers, tape, calculators, rubber bands, paperclips,
- Unused blank binders (1/2" – 2" only, NO logos)
- Envelopes

We occasionally get overloaded with items that we would normally accept and can no longer take them until we clear some inventory space

# The Art SHAC Does Not take:

- Clothing of any kind – not even as fabric or scrap
- Bed Sheets – not even as fabric or scrap
- Carpet – Check local recycling options
- Household Paint – check local recycling options
- Household Goods and Appliances
- Knick-Knacks, Toys, Stuffed Toys
- Furniture, Large Items
- Computers, printers, ink cartridges, software Food Containers or Tupperware, Kitchen gear, pots and pans, cutlery,
- Plastic utensils
- Twist ties
- Broken glass, dishware, ceramics
- No food-including dried beans and macaroni for crafts
- Packing Peanuts – bring them to a shipping store
- Artist Chemicals that are not in original labeled packaging
- Styrofoam
- Plastic pieces larger than 8"x8"
- Sheet glass with no frame
- Toilet Paper Rolls, Paper Towel Rolls, or Egg Cartons
- Complete games and puzzles
- Science, news, or other text-heavy magazines or books
- White or beige tile
